

Platform Privacy Policy

The platform available at <https://sparta.akropolis.io/>, including software, components, API, mobile, and other applications available through such platform or related to it (collectively, the “**Platform**”), is operated by Akropolis Decentralised Ltd, a company incorporated under the laws of Gibraltar (“**Akropolis**”, “**we**”, or “**our**”).

1. PERSONAL DATA THAT WE PROCESS

In order to enable you to use the Platform, Akropolis must receive your public address (starting with "0x") in the Ethereum blockchain (the “**Address**”), which, in certain circumstances, may be considered personal data. We collect your Address when you connect your digital wallet, such as, for illustration purposes only, MetaMask or Bitski, to the Platform.

2. HOW WE USE THE PERSONAL DATA

We use the Address to enable you to use the Platform. The legal basis for the processing of the Address is the necessity for the performance of a contract between you and us, meaning the Terms of Service available at [link of the Platform Terms of Service].
